## **CAMPAIGN AGAINST DENGUE**

1. The warmer months of June, July and August will bring with them more cases of Dengue Fever. To pre-empt this expected increase, National Environment Agency (NEA) will be intensifying its efforts to eliminate mosquito breeding and possible breeding habitats.
2. A thorough sweep covering all Town Councils and residential areas in all 84 constituencies will be conducted for four weeks from 17 April to 19 May 06.
3. This intensive ground operation will be concurrently executed by officers from NEA's five regional offices and its partners in the various Town Councils and Inter-Agency Dengue Task Force including the Singapore Sports Council, Land Transport Authority, Housing Development Board and Singapore Land Authority.

### Targeted premises

4. NEA's collaborative efforts will focus on potential breeding habitats near homes such as the drains in common areas of landed property residences, condominiums and HDB homes. These extensive source reduction efforts will also cover common corridors, pump rooms and roof tops at HDB blocks. Bus shelters, playgrounds, bin-centres in all residential neighbourhoods as well as hawker centres, coffeeshops, places of worship and sports complexes will also be targeted in this exercise.
5. Schools, parks, homes for the aged, construction sites (private and government), roads and rail, housing, offices and buildings will be included in this exercise too.

### You too can play a part
