CS NOTICE: QUERY RATES ON CADASTRAL JOBS SUBMITTED BY REGISTERED SURVEYORS(MONTH OF APRIL 07)

Please refer to Annex A. The query rate for the month of April 2007 is 64.2%.

The query rate has only improved a fraction. As you would agree, this situation is undesirable and does not reflect well on the quality of cadastral survey jobs provided. We would like to again remind registered surveyors who submit query-prone jobs that they need to put in more effort to carry out their jobs thoroughly and effectively before submission. The objective is to see the query rate drops to 5%. We seek your cooperation to achieve this target. Let us work together to achieve this objective which will be for the benefits of all involved. As practitioners, please feel free to give us your point of view if any. We would welcome any feedback / proposal to improve this situation.

At this high rate, it is under our close monitoring and we may have to take appropriate option if the situation does not improve.

To those registered surveyors who submit query-free jobs, we like to thank you very much for the jobs well done and would like to convey our appreciation. Please continue with the good efforts.
