STRATA TITLE PLAN (LIMITED COMMON PROPERTY) - STP(LCP)

Division 7 (comprising Sections 76 to 83) of the Building Maintenance and Strata Management Act 2004 (BMSMA), Part VII of the Building Maintenance (Strata Management) Regulations 2005 and the Building Maintenance and Strata Management (Strata Units) Regulations 2005 contain the provisions for Subsidiary Management Corporations and Limited Common Property (LCP). A two-tier management corporation (MC) is made up of 2 levels of management – a main MC at the 1st tier and one or more subsidiary management corporations (sub-MCs) at the 2nd tier. Every 2-tier MC has at least 1 sub-MC. Each sub-MC represents the interest of a particular group of strata property owners having common interest. Example: A residential sub-MC, an office sub-MC and a shop sub-MC in a mixed-use development.

- Pursuant to Section 78 of the BMSMA, the strata title plan showing common property designated as LCP shall be filed with the Chief Surveyor. Registered Surveyors, who are engaged by their clients (ie land owners/developers) to submit such strata title plans, termed as STP(LCP), to the Chief Surveyor for filing, shall prepare such STP(LCP) to meet the requirements of the BMSMA and any other technical requirements. As this is a new area of work for Registered Surveyors, you are advised to be familiarized with the whole process leading to the submission of the STP(LCP) for filing with the Chief Surveyor.
- 3 Section 78(9) of the BMSMA is self-explanatory on the Chief Surveyor's position on accepting the STP(LCP) and filing it in SLA. His acceptance of the STP(LCP) shall not be taken to warrant or certify as to the correctness of the boundaries of the LCP or the validity of the creation of such LCP and he is not to be responsible for the contents in the STP(LCP). As such, his checking and approval are not required.
- For new strata developments involving LCP, please ensure that the STP and STP(LCP) are submitted simultaneously. Please also complete the items marked for STP(LCP) submission in the survey report form. Otherwise, the submission is incomplete and a re-submission will be required.

For each submission of the STP(LCP), a filing fee is payable. The fee chargeable is \$240+\$A*+7% GST where \$A* is \$100 for each incremental range of 200 sheets of the STP(LCP) and is calculated as follows:

(a) From 1 to 200 sheets = \$240+\$100+\$23.80cts = \$363.80cts (b) From 201 to 400 sheets = \$240+\$200+\$30.80cts = \$470.80cts (c) From 401 to 600 sheets = \$240+\$300+\$37.80cts = \$577.80cts

...... (and so on for every increment in range of 200 sheets)

Example: For a STP(LCP) of 218 sheets, the fee is \$470.80cts.

When submitting the STP(LCP), please complete the "Authorization for deduction of survey fee" form for us to deduct the fee from your bank account via GIRO.
