CS CIRCULAR NO. 1/2012

To: All Registered Surveyors

SURVEY AND MARKING OF NEW CURVE BOUNDARIES

Rule 24(11) of the Boundaries and Survey Maps (Conduct of Cadastral Surveys) Rules requires curve-boundaries to be marked by straight lines on the ground such that no point on the curve is more than 20 centimetres from such straight lines. Registered Surveyors shall continue with this existing practice.

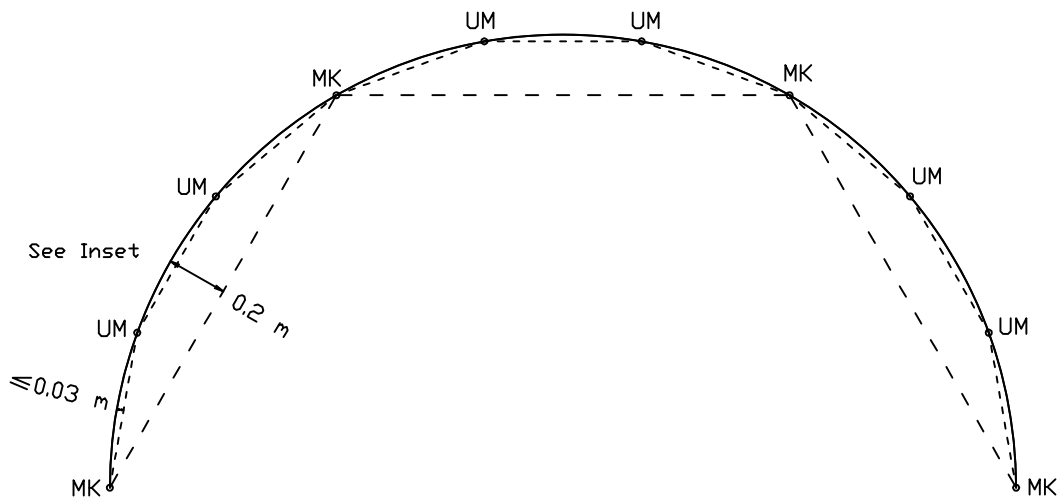
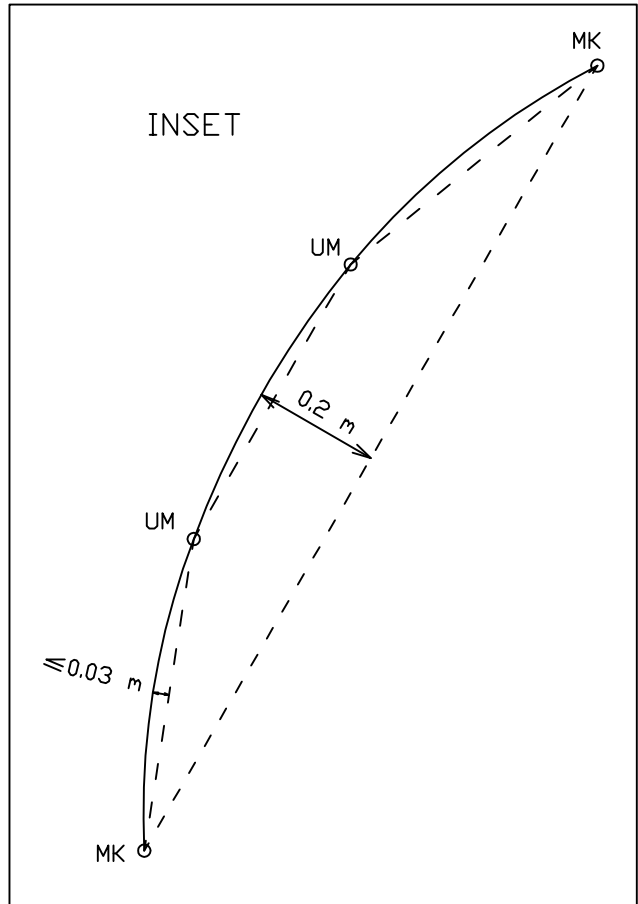
2 We have reviewed the present scenario of cases whereby these new curve-boundaries cut into drains and other structures, resulting in the creation of encroachments. To alleviate such undesirable situations, Registered Surveyors should create unmarked points in between to ensure the crown distance is not more than 0.03m. See illustration in Annex A.

3 The above new practice will come into operation for field survey carry out on 18 Jun 2012 onwards. You may also submit jobs in accordance with the new practice before this date.
