General

- 1. Visitors are encouraged to do their part to keep the national monument clean and litter free for all to enjoy.**
- 2. Visitors should exercise caution and be responsible for their own safety.**
- 3. To help preserve the national monument, the following activities will not be allowed within the premises:**
 - Busking**
 - Commercial activities**
 - Sports activities, including wheeled sports such as cycling and roller blading**
 - Littering**
 - Smoking**
 - Consumption of alcoholic drinks**
 - Pets (except for guide dogs)**

 - Members of the public can drop off their drawings (indicating their names and contact numbers at the back) at the former ticketing counter of TPRS. There will be signage to guide the public on the submission of their drawings.**
