

Guidelines for Academic/Educational Purposes Scheme

1. If you are an academic or educational institution registered with the Ministry of Education, Singapore, and providing instruction in Singapore in global positioning systems ("GPS"), you may apply for free access to either or both of the SiReNT Services known as "Real Time Kinematic Service (RTK)" or "Differential Global Positioning System Service (DGNSS/DGPS)", by submitting the application form, duly completed and signed, to Singapore Land Authority, 55 Newton Road, #12-01 Revenue House, Singapore 307987 (Attn : Land Survey Division). The application form is available on the website <http://app1.sla.gov.sg/sirent> under "Downloads".
2. SLA may, at its absolute discretion, approve or reject any application for free access to SiReNT Services under the Academic/Educational Purposes Scheme.
3. Each successful applicant may access and use the RTK Service or the DGNSS Service or both Services for free for the duration ("Free Access Period") of the course/module stipulated in Part 3 of the application form, for the sole purpose of aiding or facilitating instruction in Singapore in the subject of GPS/GNSS to the students enrolled in the applicant institution.
4. The login identification and password issued to the successful applicant shall only be divulged to teachers, instructors or lecturers employed or engaged under contract as part of the staff of the applicant institution.
5. The successful applicant shall comply with all circulars, directions and instructions which may be issued by SLA pertaining to the confidentiality, security and use of any login identification and password issued to the applicant.
6. SLA reserves the right to terminate the provision of free access to any SiReNT Service(s) at any time without advance notice.
7. A successful applicant may terminate its free access to a SiReNT Service at any time before the expiry of the Free Access Period, upon giving notice in writing to SLA.
8. SLA may, from time to time, amend, vary, or withdraw this Scheme and these guidelines without prior notice. These guidelines are not binding on and do not form part of any offer or contract with SLA.
